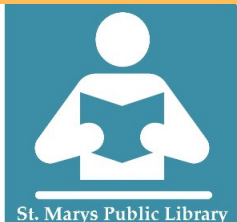

FAMILY STEAM DAY

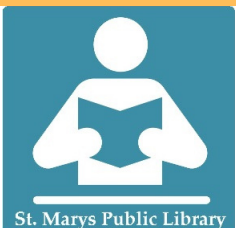
Monday, October 16th from 10 am - 6 pm
